



# Story Map Poster

How much do you remember about the story you read? This decorative poster will help you show all that you know.

## Materials

- one sheet of lined writing paper
- assorted colors of construction paper
- one large sheet of posterboard or tagboard
- pencil
- black marker
- scissors
- glue

## Directions

1. Make a list of sentences telling about characters and events in the story you read.
2. Cut out 3" shapes from colored construction paper for each sentence that you wrote.
3. Using the black marker, write each sentence neatly on a shape.
4. Arrange the shapes on the posterboard or tagboard in the order that they happened in the story. (Leave space at the top of the poster for the book title.) Arrange the shapes so that they are about 2" apart and glue them in place.
5. Use the black marker to draw an arrow between the shapes. This will guide the reader's eye to each event in the correct sequence.
6. Complete the project by writing the title of the book in large letters at the top of the poster.
